Example 1: Picture Book Review - "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" by Eric Carle

My Book Review

Tips for Writing Your Own Elementary Book Review

- 1. **Start with the basics:** Write the title and author
- 2. **Tell what it's about:** Give a short summary (2-3 sentences)
- 3. **Share what you liked:** List 3-4 things you enjoyed
- 4. Share what you didn't like: It's okay to say 1-2 things you didn't enjoy
- 5. **Give your opinion:** Would you tell a friend to read it?
- 6. Rate it: Use stars or numbers

Remember: There are no wrong opinions in a book review. It's YOUR thoughts about the book!
