3. Source Credibility

For each source, answer:

- Is the author or organization reputable? Yes / No
 - Is the information accurate and verifiable? Yes / No
 - Is it relevant to your comparison criteria? Yes / No
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4. Balanced Information Check

- Do you have roughly equal information for both subjects? Yes / No
- Will this allow fair, meaningful comparison? Yes / No

- Expanding to more documented subjects
- Replacing the topic

5. Research Depth

Do your sources provide enough detail to cover your planned essay length?

6. Access Check

Can you access these sources?

- Freely available online: Yes / No

7. Final Research Readiness

Your topic is ready if all criteria are met:

- Sufficient depth for meaningful analysis
- Sources are accessible
