Content Quality

Coverage - ☐ All major themes identified - ☐ Key characters analyzed - ☐ Important symbols/motifs included - ☐ Significant quotes with page numbers - ☐ Plot summary without excessive detail

Depth - ☐ Goes beyond plot summary - ☐ Includes interpretation, not just facts - ☐ Connects themes to broader meanings - ☐ Addresses author's techniques - ☐ Contains original insights

Organization

Structure - ☐ Logical organization (chronological, thematic, or by element) - ☐ Clear sections with headings - ☐ Easy to navigate quickly - ☐ Information easy to locate during exam - ☐ Consistent formatting throughout

Visual Design - ☐ Uses bullet points for scannability - ☐ Includes white space (not wall of text) - ☐ Highlights or bold for key terms - ☐ Color coding if applicable - ☐ Charts/diagrams for complex relationships

Usability

Accessibility - ☐ Written in your own words (not copied) - ☐ Language you actually understand - ☐ Examples that make sense to you - ☐ Mnemonics or memory aids included - ☐ Cross-references between related concepts

Practicality - ☐ Length appropriate for review (not too long) - ☐ Focuses on exam-relevant material - ☐ Practice questions included - ☐ Potential essay prompts listed - ☐ Can review entire guide in 30-60 minutes

Study Strategies

Active Learning - ☐ Space for your annotations - ☐ Practice questions with answers - ☐ Compare/contrast sections - ☐ "Test yourself" opportunities - ☐ Connections to class discussions

Comprehension Checks - ☐ Can explain concepts without looking - ☐ Can provide examples independently - ☐ Able to connect themes across text - ☐ Can argue different interpretations - ☐ Ready to write essay without guide

Final Test

The 24-Hour Test - ☐ Review guide 24 hours before exam - ☐ Can recall major themes - ☐ Can identify 5+ important quotes - ☐ Can outline essay response - ☐ Feel confident about material
