## MLA (9th Edition)

#### **In-Text Citations**

• **Author** + **Page:** (Smith 42)

• No author: ("Article Title" 7)

#### Works Cited — Books

#### **Format:**

Author Last, First. Title of Book. Publisher, Year.

#### **Example:**

Smith, John. Learning in Context. Beacon Press, 2021.

#### **Works Cited — Journal Articles**

#### **Format:**

Author Last, First. "Article Title." *Journal Name*, vol. #, no. #, Year, pp. xx–xx.

#### **Example:**

Lopez, Maria. "Cognitive Mapping in Early Childhood." *Education Review*, vol. 14, no. 2, 2022, pp. 45–67.

#### Works Cited — Websites

#### Format

Author Last, First. "Page Title." Website Name, Publisher, Date, URL.

#### **Example:**

Turner, Alex. "The Future of Study Skills." *Academic Hub*, 2023, www.academichub.org/future-skills.

# APA (7th Edition)

#### **In-Text Citations**

- **Author** + **Year**: (Smith, 2021)
- **Direct quote with page:** (Smith, 2021, p. 42)

#### **References** — Books

#### Format:

Author Last, First Initial. (Year). Title of book. Publisher.

#### **Example:**

Smith, J. (2021). Learning in context. Beacon Press.

#### **References** — Journal Articles

#### Format:

Author Last, First Initial. (Year). Article title. Journal Title, volume(issue), pages.

#### **Example:**

Lopez, M. (2022). Cognitive mapping in early childhood. *Education Review*, 14(2), 45–67.

#### **References** — Websites

#### Format:

Author Last, First Initial. (Year, Month Day). Page title. Website Name. URL

#### **Example:**

Turner, A. (2023, March 12). The future of study skills. *Academic Hub*. https://www.academichub.org/future-skills

# **Chicago (Notes & Bibliography)**

#### **In-Text/Footnotes**

- First note: full citation
- Later notes: shortened author + title + page

### **Bibliography** — **Books**

#### **Format:**

Author Last, First. Title of Book. Publisher, Year.

#### **Example:**

Smith, John. Learning in Context. Beacon Press, 2021.

### **Bibliography** — **Journal Articles**

#### Format:

Author Last, First. "Article Title." Journal Name volume, no. issue (Year): pages.

#### **Example:**

Lopez, Maria. "Cognitive Mapping in Early Childhood." *Education Review* 14, no. 2 (2022): 45–67.

### **Bibliography** — Websites

#### Format:

Author Last, First. "Page Title." Website Name. Last modified Date. URL.

#### **Example:**

Turner, Alex. "The Future of Study Skills." *Academic Hub*. Accessed March 20, 2023. https://www.academichub.org/future-skills.
