

Revision & Editing Checklist for Persuasive Essays

1. Thesis & Argument

- Is the thesis statement clear and specific?
- Does each paragraph support the thesis?
- Are counterarguments addressed effectively?

2. Organization & Flow

- Are ideas presented in a logical order?
- Are transitions smooth between paragraphs?
- Does the introduction grab attention and set context?
- Does the conclusion summarize key points and reinforce the thesis?

3. Evidence & Support

- Are claims supported with credible sources and facts?
- Are examples and details relevant and convincing?
- Is reasoning clear and logical?

4. Language & Tone

- Is the language formal, clear, and persuasive?
- Are sentences varied in structure?
- Are rhetorical techniques (ethos, pathos, logos) used effectively?

5. Grammar, Spelling & Mechanics

- Check for spelling errors.
- Check punctuation and capitalization.
- Ensure proper sentence structure and word choice.

6. Formatting & Citations

- Is the essay formatted according to the required style (MLA, APA, etc.)?
- Are citations and references accurate and complete?

7. Final Review

- Read aloud to check for clarity and flow.
- Remove any unnecessary words or repetition.
- Ensure the essay presents a strong, persuasive argument.
