1. Deadline Urgency (Max 40 points)

What is Buffer Time?

Buffer time is extra time added to your estimates to account for:

- Unexpected delays (technical issues, research taking longer)
- Life interruptions (illness, family emergencies, other assignments)
- Underestimating task difficulty
- Procrastination recovery time

Recommended Buffer: 20-30% of total estimated time

□ DAILY ROTATION STRATEGY

Time-Blocking for Multiple Essays

Strategy 1: Single-Essay Focus Days

- Best for: Deep work, drafting full sections
- Assign each essay a dedicated day
- Complete one phase entirely before switching

Strategy 2: Split-Day Rotation

- Best for: Maintaining momentum on all essays
- Morning: High-priority essay (3-4 hours)
- Afternoon: Medium-priority essay (2-3 hours)
- Evening: Quick tasks on low-priority essay (1 hour)

Strategy 3: Task-Based Batching

- Best for: Similar tasks across essays
- Research day: Find sources for Essays 1, 2, 3
- Drafting day: Write introductions for all essays
- Editing day: Proofread completed sections

Red Flags That You're Falling Behind

 \square Missing multiple target completion dates \square Constantly working on lowest-priority essays \square Sacrificing sleep to meet deadlines \square Skipping revision/editing phases \square Feeling overwhelmed/paralyzed

Emergency Triage Protocol

If you're behind schedule:

Step 1: Recalculate Priorities

- Update deadline urgency scores
- Identify which essay matters most RIGHT NOW

Step 2: Simplify Lower-Priority Essays

• Can you narrow the scope?

- Can you use fewer sources?
- Can you write to minimum word count?

Step 3: Ask for Help

- Request extension (if policy allows)
- Visit professor's office hours
- Use campus writing center
- Consider professional writing services for time-critical essays

Step 4: Damage Control

- Focus on highest-priority essays only
- Accept lower grades on less-weighted assignments
- Submit something rather than nothing (partial credit > zero)

First Draft Phase:

• 1,000 words: 3-4 hours

• 1,500 words: 5-6 hours

• 2,000 words: 6-8 hours

• 2,500 words: 8-10 hours

• Add 1-2 hours for citations

Revision Phase:

• Light revision: 1-2 hours

• Moderate revision: 2-3 hours

• Heavy revision: 3-5 hours

Editing & Formatting Phase:

• Grammar/spelling check: 1 hour

• Citation formatting: 1-2 hours

• Final proofread: 30-60 minutes

• Total: 2.5-4 hours
